WELL, THE DELUGE OF CHRISTMAS SNOW SCUPPERED THE PLANS OF A FEW PLAYERS WHO INTENDED TO PLAY THIS TOURNAMENT BUT ONCE THE "CHEZGER" CONTINGENT CONFIRMED THAT THEY WERE DRIVING DOWN FROM CHESTER, IT HAD TO GO AHEAD.

EVENTUALLY, WE STARTED WITH 15 PLAYERS & 3 OF THE 'CHESTER-FOUR' WENT ON TO MAKE THE FINAL TABLE, AS DID TOD WOOD'S BROTHER-IN-LAW LEE SMITH, TO GIVE US 5 NON-BCPC IN THE FINAL 9.

FIRST TO GO WAS THE IRREPRESSIBLE GER SMYTH SNR WITH A-10 VS LEE'S A-J & HE WAS FOLLOWED BY DANNY YATES, WHOSE ATTEMPT TO BLUFF A-L IN WITH A-8 ON A K-K-X-X BOARD FAILED AS CARL LYBERT SHOWED K-7. MATT LEFT IN 7TH IN A CLASSIC Q-Q VS TONY TRIPPIER'S A-K BEFORE BRIAN WENT IN 6TH AS HIS SHOVE WITH Q-9 GOT CALLED BY CRAIG McINNES' A-Q.

CARL LYBERT BUBBLED THE MONEY IN 5TH, WITH WILL PICKING UP £50 FOR 4TH PLACE.

AT THIS STAGE CRAIG McINNES LOOKED THE LIKELY WINNER UNTIL HE RAN A-J INTO LEE'S A-Q TO EXIT IN 3RD TO PICK UP £86.

HEADS-UP & TONY TRIPPIER GOT VERY UNLUCKY WHEN A BIG FAVORITE TO LEAVE HIM SHORT-STACKED AND HE NEVER RECOVERED, EVENTUALLY COLLECTING £234 FOR 2ND AND THAT MEANT THAT LEE SMITH WAS THE CHAMPION & £382 BETTER OFF.

APAT TEAM TOURNAMENT 2011

AS YOU CAN SEE FROM THE ABOVE RANKINGS, THERE WERE NO CHANGES THAT AFFECTED OUR TEAM FOR THIS EVENT FROM THE WEEK 1 STANDINGS. THEREFORE THE TOP 6 RANKED PLAYERS, PLUS MATT MCKINLAY AND ANDY DUNCAN WILL MAKE UP OUR TEAM IN BOLTON ON THE WEEKEND OF NOVEMBER 29TH/30TH. GOOD LUCK GUYS AND T.I.D.

WALSALL ARE APAT NATIONAL ONLINE CHAMPIONS... AGAIN !

LAST SUNDAY, THE WALSALL TEAM, CONSISTING ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY OF BCPC PLAYERS, CLINCHED THE APAT NATIONAL ONLINE DIVISION ONE LEAGUE TITLE FOR THE 2ND TIME IN 3 SEASONS.

ANDY BARTON CAME FIRST ON SUNDAY & THOSE 18 POINTS MOVED HIM UP INTO 3RD PLACE TO JOIN TONY TRIPPIER & JOINT OVERALL TOP LEAGUE SCORERS ANDY OVERTON & JAMES EDWARDS IN GAINING A £1070 GUKPT SEAT FOR 2011.

"BARTY'S" WIN MEANT THAT LONG-TIME TOP 4 MEMBER DEBJANI DUNCAN UNFORTUNATELY MISSED OUT ON A SEAT ON THE FINAL DAY.

ALL THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE WALSALL TEAM WHO SCORED POINTS DURING THE SEASON WILL RECEIVE A % OF ANY MONEY WON BY THESE 4 PLAYERS AT THE GUKPT, PRO-RATA TO THE AMOUNT OF POINTS THEY SCORED, SUBJECT TO AGREEMENT BY ALL 4 OF THESE PLAYERS.

BCPC GET ANOTHER CASH

LAST WEEKEND, MALCOLM HOWELL PLAYED THE £336 EVENT AT DTD AS HIS PRIZE FOR WINNING 2ND PLACE IN THE BCPC SEASON THREE. UNFORTUNATELY MALC CRASHED OUT IN 112TH BUT IT WAS BETTER NEWS ALL ROUND JUST A DAY LATER AT THE SAME VENUE WHEN BRIAN YATES COMPLETED IN THE £168, £300 GUARANTEED EVENT.

BOTH BRIAN, REPRESENTING THE BCPC AFTER WINNING THE HEADS-UP EVENT IN SEASON 3, AND CLIVE PADDERN FOR THE SOUTH SHROPSHIRE POKER CLUB, MADE THE FINAL TABLE WHERE ALL 9 PLAYERS AGREED TO TAKE A MINIMUM £1000 JUST ONE HAND IN.

ONCE DOWN TO 7 HANDED, A £3000 MINIMUM WAS AGREED AND BRIAN ENDED UP FINISHING 6TH AFTER RUNNING A-K INTO THE MONSTER THAT IS 6-6.

BRIAN KEEPS £1500, PLUS THE £150 BUY-IN, WHILE THE OTHER 11 PLAYERS WHO ENTERED THE SEASON 3 HEADS-UP TOURNAMENT SHARE £1350 WHICH EQUATES TO £122.72 EACH.

CLIVE MADE THE TOP 4, WHO THEN CHIPPED WHAT WAS LEFT, WINNING JUST OVER £4100. WELL DONE CLIVE !

B.C.P.C. TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS 2011

LAYOUT OF THIS EVENT

This event will be played on 5 tables with 1 member of each team on each table. On each table, points will be awarded as follows - 1st = 10pts, 2nd = 7, 3rd = 4, 4th = 2, 5th = 1. There will be a £50 prize to the winner of each table. This process will be repeated 3 times, so EVERY PLAYER plays a minimum of 3 games and can win a maximum of £150 at this level.

There will be a 15-min clock with a 3000 starting stack and blinds at 25-50, 50-100, 75-150, 100-200, 200-400, 300-600, 400-800, 500-1000, 1000-2000.

The start times for each round are expected to be (approx) 1pm, 4pm, 7.45pm with the Final commencing at around 10.30pm.

The Final will be contested by THE HIGHEST POINTS-SCORER from EACH team so even if you did not win in the group stage, you could still have a shot at the UKIPT seat as the highest scorer overall.

The highest overall points scorer before the Final wins £200. The starting chips for each player at the Final Table will be determined by the TOTAL points gained in the 3 group games by ALL of the members of each team, at the rate of 150 chips per point. This will give a total of 54000 chips in play at the Final Table, although no player will start with less than 1000.

The winner of the Final Table wins a £550 UKIPT entry, with that player keeping 50% of any cash won in the event and the other 50% being shared equally with his 4 teammates.

All of these prize payouts are based on 10 teams of 5 players entering the tournament.
