APAT UK TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS 2011

This will take place at the G-Casino in Luton on October 22nd/23rd and our team for this event will be chosen from the rankings after tonight's game, although **Clive Padden** is not available and **Will Young** will not be considered after letting us down in Blackpool.

5 players are assured of a place in the team irrespective of how they finish tonight as even not making the Final Table would leave them with enough ranking points to stay in the top 7. They are **Brian Yates (Capt)**, **Andy Duncan**, **Matt McKinlay**, **Ant Williams** and **Tony Trippier**. **Tod Wood** will have a ranking of 2.213 should he not reach tonight's FT and it would take a strange set of results for him not to stay in the top 7. **Steve Redfern** is not playing tonight so his ranking will stay at 2.258....so what do the others have to do?

Well **Malcolm Howell** is under pressure as despite sitting on a ranking of 2.256 currently, he loses a 3rd place finish after tonight's game so anything less than that will see his ranking drop. **Malc** would rank 1.853 if finishing 1st tonight, a 3rd place would see him on 2.253 (ahead of **Steve Redfern**) while he needs at least an 8th place finish to put him on 2.42 as anything less would mean he could not possibly make the team.

Andy Overton will finish on 2.433 even if he doesn't reach the FT tonight but will that be enough? Well a 6th place would mean a ranking of 2.254 (ahead of **Steve**) and 4th would be 2.187 and probably enough as **Malc** would HAVE to win to be ahead of him.

Only 3 other players can possibly make the team and they all HAVE to win to have the chance to do so. They are **Rob Hewlitt** (2.164 with a win), **Paul Melia** (2.365) and **Richard Davis** (2.283).

Confirmation of the team will be announced on the website and Facebook tomorrow and we can then sort some accommodation for the Saturday night and possibly transport for some.

VEGAS DREAM FINAL

This fantastic tournament is almost upon us and will be played on **SATURDAY OCTOBER 8TH** starting at 2.00pm sharp.

This tournament is only open to past and present members of the BCPC. Entry is £100 for 5000 chips and everyone is entitled to at least one buy-in but players who have won a BCPC live game can purchase additional entries for £100 for 5000 chips, up to a maximum of 20,000.

Anyone winning a satellite, either live or online, can purchase an additional 5000 chips but nobody can start with more than 20,000 on the day.

For the first 2 levels on the night, anyone falling below 3000 chips may purchase an additional 3000 chips for £50 or can rebuy back in if eliminated for £100 for 5000 chips.

At the end of Level 2, add-ons of 3000 chips for £50 can be purchased if required.

1. Return flights (currently £400 each) for **TWO PEOPLE** from London on November 15th to Las Vegas staying for 7 nights at the Imperial Palace hotel (room approx £170 for 7 nights) on the Las Vegas strip.

2. Entry to the \$350 Venetian Deepstack tournament (12,000 starting stack) on Thursday November 17th @ noon representing the BCPC on a 50/50 basis, as per club rules.

3. £75 entry to the APAT event to be held on 19th/20th November (venue TBC) representing the BCPC on a 50/50 basis, as per club rules.

Total cost is approximately £1255 so any money left over will be given as spending money for the winner to use as he sees fit.

The flights that I have priced up are 1-stoppers on both outward and inward journeys. If you wish to fly direct from Gatwick, the current cost is £570 each and if you wish to stay at any other accommodation, or for a longer time, that is entirely up to the winning player. All we ask is that you go out on the date stipulated and play the 2 events listed here.

Also, as the flights leave just 5 weeks after our game is played, please book everything IMMEDIATELY on the next day after you have won to avoid any additional price rises.
