BCPC TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS 2015

This year's event looks set to break all records with 19 teams now registered, with 4 of them being BCPC teams. This is amazing in that a lot of the usual suspects are unable to make it this year, yet the team numbers have rocketed.

The BCPC Double D team will be returning to defend their Title and the other 3 teams will be determined once **Tod** has compiled the new rankings after tonight's game.

Our 3 teams will be chosen firstly by ranked players currently playing, then unranked players currently playing, then by ranked and unranked players not currently playing and finally anyone else who is left!

The event will be played as in the past, that is 3 sit-n-go games over the course of the day with points awarded to the top 5 players as follows....1st = 10 pts, 2nd = 7, 3rd = 4, 4th = 2 & 5th = 1 point. The winner of each table will receive £35 and the overall individual scoring the most total points over the three games will take home £160 with the runner-up getting £100. The winning team will receive 2 x £440 GPS seats and 3 x £220 25/25 entries (£1540 in total).

There will be a twist to the points scoring in that each team will have a "Wild-Card" player. This player will be drawn at random and for one of the three rounds, the points that this player scores will count as double (the round will also be drawn at random). Also, whoever knocks this player out, his points scored **IN THAT GAME ONLY** will also be doubled. Of course, if the wild card goes out before 5th he scores zero.....and if the player who knocks him out also doesn't make the top 5 then twice zero is still zero! These extra points will **NOT** count towards a player's individual points total though, only to the team totals.

The game is being played at the Britannia Inn which is a superb venue for us. The food should be good too and we are ok to play into the early hours as we do at The Talbot. Please remember though, I do not know the gaffer and he does not know us so try and be sensible with your behaviour on the day.

Also, I would hope that I will not be left to clear everything up like last year. Please try to stay and help and then it will not take long at all to do. We will all want to get home when it is over.....even me ☺

BCPC COFFERS BOOSTED AGAIN

Steve Healey used the £440 seat he got for winning the League last season, at Star City last weekend in the GPS and after a superb performance, cashed for **£860**, of which **£230** will be added to the fund for payout in a few months time. **Steve Redfern** also cashed for **£860** but both players were eclipsed on Sunday by **Sean Priest**, who came so close to winning his first APAT Title in Coventry, before having to settle for **£1950** for 3rd place.
