It has been a cracking month for our players with **Ricky Buckland & Claire Bailey** leading the way on Friday January 5th at Resorts World, finishing 1st & 3rd respectively, with **Claire** pocketing **£882** and **Ricky** a career best **£1500**. Not a bad start to 2018!

Brian Yates was 4th in APAT's English Online Open, just missing out on his 13th APAT medal, but collecting **£204** as a consolation prize.

Adam Phelan starred for the BCPC in the recent Champions League game, finishing 1st for **£225** with **Mark England** 2nd for **£110**, although they did pool this with **Tony Trippier's** **£15** for coming last and split the proceeds with their team mates.

THE CHAMPIONS LEAGUE RETURNS

Robbie Dodds of Nuts "A" eventually did just that and so his team had won the trophy. That was **Adam's** cue to move into Beast-Mode as he took out all of the final three Nuts players to win the individual crown with **Mark** in 2nd, meaning they missed out on the win by just a single point.
