WEEK 2 MILESTONES

MATT MCKINLAY equalled the Club record of 9 wins, held jointly by **TOD WOOD & ADAM PHELAN** and in doing so, by beating **TOD** Heads-Up, gave him the record for 2nd places, also with 9.

TOD'S 12 points gained (while wearing the Shirt Of Shame!) were enough to move him past **TONY TRIPPIER** to become the highest points scorer in Club History with 470. He also extended his record for most cashes to 31, 2 ahead of **TONY**, while **NIC CROSS** (5th) made his first cash.

MATT became the new BCPC No.1-ranked player after his win, the 9th occasion he has been top-dog.

MARK ENGLAND tied **JAKE POXON'S** record for most games played (56) without getting your first win and could take it outright tonight. Both are still more than 2 seasons away from **PAUL FOY'S** record run for most games in a row without a win, which stands at 73.

DAVE HALLIDAY, AMY COSHAN & LAURA RHODEN have all made both Final Tables so far in Season 26, with **AMY** now becoming the 44th different player to top the League at the BCPC.

Former leader **MANDEEP SINGH** will tonight be wearing the Shirt Of Shame, the 76th different player to do so.

Only 7 current players, who have played 10 or more games, now have a Final Table % of over 50%...**ANDY DUNCAN** (1st, 70.37%), **JACK WARBURTON** (=4), **STEVE HEALEY** (6), **ADAM SHARPLES** (=9), **MATT MCKINLAY** (11), **TONY TRIPPIER** (14) & **TOD WOOD** (15).

STEVE HEALEY (3rd) gained points in his 19th consecutive season & **MATT MCKINLAY** in his 17th, keeping alive their record of never scoring zero points in a season.

RULE CHANGE

Currently, if you don't turn up on time, your chips automatically go in play from Level 1, as they do in most comps. From Level 4, you then post a SB & BB on every hand. This rule is to avoid a situation which occurred in Season 1 Week 2, when a player didn't play a hand, yet finished 4th.

From tonight, there will be a slight change to our "Sit-Out" rule, in that if you announce prior to the game that you will be arriving at a time AFTER THE BREAK, then you will NOT be required to post the SB/BB on every hand, up until your announced arrival time.

BCPC CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS MEMORIAL GAME 2022

This proved to be a cracking night's poker, as 14 players played for the right to call themselves BCPC Champion Of Champions for 2022. By the break, all 14 were still in, with Season 24 Champion **WILL YOUNG** leading the way, followed closely by **MANDEEP SINGH** and **ADAM PHELAN**, with **TOD WOOD** the shortstack with 21BB's.

We had reached Level 5 when **TOD** shoved AQ and **NIC RAWLINGS** had him in trouble with AK...but 5 spades on board gave us a chop. **GAZ** was the next all-in on the turn Vs **NIC CROSS** & he rivered the straight to double-up nicely.

KEV BERRIE became the first casualty and was quickly followed by **CHARLES MASON**. His Qs-Qc went up against **NIC CROSS'S** 9h-9d and with 5 hearts on board, **NIC** got lucky.

GAZ eliminated PLO Champion **ANDRE CROSSFIELD** in 12th before **WILL** went in 11th to take us to the brink of the Final Table. **TOD** was still short and looked in bad shape when his shove with Kd 2d got called by **NIC RAWLINGS'** A-8 but a K on the flop gave **TOD** the desired Double-Up. The very next hand **TOD** shoved K-high again, only this time it was into **LEE MASON'S** A-K...but amazingly, a 9-river eliminated **LEE** and **TOD** was now chipped-up.

The Final Table quickly lost **ADAM PHELAN** (8-8 into **JACK WARBURTON'S** AA) and **STEVE HEALEY** before **GAZ** shoved K-10 into **MATT MCKINLAY'S** A-K and failed to "Do a TOD!" **JACK** was then eliminated by **NIC CROSS** in 6th before a short-stacked **NIC RAWLINGS** ran Q-10 into the now dominant TOD'S Kings. 4 left and **MANDEEP'S** shove with K-J held Vs **NIC'S** Q-J leaving **NIC** crippled but when **NIC** shoved Ks-Qs he had **TOD** (10s-8s) groaning....until he flopped 2 pair, leaving the last 3 in the money. **MANDEEP** was a tiny stack and would surely finish 3rd...but on a board of 8d-9c-7c, **TOD** (Kc-Jc) got it all-in behind vs **MATT'S** Qc-8s. The 9d kept **MATT** ahead but the 10c on the river gave **TOD** a monster stack.

The Heads-Up only lasted 4 hands, with **TOD** playing a flopped trip eights superbly, allowing **MANDEEP'S** A-K to seemingly catch up with a K on the river and the resultant shove made **TOD** the first ever Champion Of Champions, his 19th BCPC Title.

The remaining 4 players each took £125 with the remaining £120 going to the winner. **DI FARRELL** was 4th, **NIC CROSS** 3rd before **ANDRE CROSSFIELD** fell just short of adding this Title to his PLO Super Summer Sizzler won in August as **MATT MCKINLAY** became our Christmas Champion for the first time, winning his 3rd BCPC Career-Title and his first PLO Title.
