The Tournament starts at 11.30am...we will NOT wait for you if you are late, so please don't be! First 2 games are 10-handed STT's with a 35-man MTT to finish. You will collect £40 if you win an STT, top 5 get in the points, with £75 for winning your MTT (£40 2nd) and top 9 in the points. Winning team will receive £1900 with £1000 for 2nd and £550 for 3rd. There is also £100 to the highest overall points scorer with £50 for 2nd.

We are running a sweep on the day, cost is £2 per go. There will be 140 player names in the hat. If the player you choose at random scores the most points, you will win half of the total pot, with the other half making up a pool to pay all of the dealers who volunteer to deal a whole table in any of the STT games. If this sells out, the prize will pay £140, so well worth a couple of shots each.

Let's bring the trophy back to the BCPC once more, but most of all, have a cracking day out 😊 .

SUMMER DEEPSTACK XIII

The sun was shining and while we couldn't play outside due to limited space, the 13th running of our annual Deepstack proved to be a massive success as we saw a record-equalling 39 players generate a record prizepool, after 18-rebuys and 37 add-ons boosted the total to £3200.

It was the first time that we had used the Horse And Jockey for a BCPC game and the consensus of opinion was that it certainly won't be the last...a superb room for poker and great food to boot.

A highlight from my own table in Level 2 was a 3-way all-in on a flop of 3-4-5. The hands were A-2, 2-6 and 6-7, meaning ALL THREE flopped the straight....the 6-7 held.

GAZ HOWARD turned up fashionably late and had to rebuy after just ONE HAND....but then later doubled-up with 6-3 on a 6-A-6-J board vs J-J....rivering quad-sixes!

By 11.30pm we were down to the last Final Table and **TONY GRIFFITHS** was now looking good after having back-to-back hands where he got it in with 10-10 vs AK on both occasions. Both times it came Ace on flop, 10 on turn !



STEVE HEALEY in 9th & **NATE POULTON** in 8th were the 2 players who failed to cash before BCPC Champion **MATT KAY** was out 7th for £100.

ADAM SMITH was the shortstack when his cards got accidentally mucked by the dealer, after he had raised....but we all know you should always protect your cards and not long after, **ADAM** exited in 6th for £150 with **GARETH RICKHUSS** going 5th for £250.

So down to the last 4 and the chip-lead moved around several times before **AL HACKETT** went in 4th for £400.

TONY GRIFFITHS & JACK HIPKISS went Heads Up in Deepstack VII, won by **TONY**. It was not to be this time though as **TONY** shoved K7 on the button, only for **JACK** to reshove his pocket 8's, which held to send him to Heads-Up with **MARK POWELL**.



JACK been beaten H/U in DSVII by **TONY** & DSVIII by **HITENDRA PATEL**, but this was to be 3rd-time lucky. He shoved his pocket 6's and got a call from **MARK** with A-5, but despite flopping a 5, there was no more help for **MARK**, who was runner-up for £750 with **JACK** lifting the trophy, plus his £1k booty.

Game Two saw 16 players do battle and only **DARREN RUMBOLD** & **DI FARRELL** were able to make it back-to-back Final Tables.
