WEEK 5 MILESTONES

MARK ENGLAND extended his record of games without a first win to 65, while **ADAM SMITH** became only the 5th player ever to go 50 games without a win

MANDEEP SINGH continues to smash records...he came as close as it is possible to be to a record 3rd consecutive win in week 5, with **DAVE HALLIDAY** becoming the first player to ever beat him Heads-Up. Those 12 points means **MANDEEP** becomes the first player EVER to take down a League Title prior to a week 6 game. Should he get 3rd or better tonight, he would beat **STEVE REDFERN'S** single-season points total set in Season 9 of 51 points. **STEVE** also won that season by a record 15 points...**MANDEEP** currently leads by 17. A top 6 finish tonight would equal the record held by **TOD WOOD & LAURA RHODEN** of 4 consecutive games with a cash. He also has now moved to No.1 in average cash per game on £21.35, moving past **ADAM SHARPLES**.

BRIAN YATES extended his record for Final Table appearances to 76 & his £70 cash for 3rd place means that **PAUL FOY** is now the biggest loser in history on **-£544**.

HITENDRA PATEL slipped to the foot of the table and now has gone 25 games without a cash, equalling the 3rd worst streak in history, with only **PAUL FOY** (32) & **LAURA RHODEN** (30) having gone longer.

MATT KAY (£570) & **ALEX BAKO** (£1015) both cashed for the BCPC in a recent Hill St comp, taking our total to 51 cashes for just under £69,000, with **ALEX** becoming the 28th different player to cash while **MATT** is the 6th player to have 3 cashes .

MATT JUDGE now has the worst Final Table % of 13.33% (2 of 15).

DAVE HALLIDAY & DAVE WHITELEY both made it 4 consecutive season's with a point while **ALEX BOLTON** made his first Final Table, scoring his first career points.
