Finally, 5th-placed Blue Blood had **NIC RAWLINGS, DI FARRELL, MATT WILSON & JO CHILLMAID** on board for £250 each.

PLO Super Summer Sizzler Champion

This potentially gives up 24 possible players, although some players will either win more than one game or, win a game and a Title in the same season. Should anyone do this, then they would only win one entry & one 10,000 starting stack in the game.

The prizepool for this game is made up of a 10% rake, which is taken from all of the above games listed in black. For the **red** listings, **NO RAKE IS TAKEN** and therefore, should the winner wish to enter, he will pay a £30 fee, unless he wins another (raked) event. Entry to this game is always optional for all qualifiers.



The 2023 Battle Of The Champions took place on January 5th with 15 players sitting down at the start and as befits such a prestigious game, we didn't lose a player until Level 6 and that was **BEN WHITAKER** going out with a flopped set of 7's vs **TONY GRIFFITHS'** flopped set of Q's!

Just minutes later we were down to 12 before **MATT KAY** became the first player to win himself a seat, courtesy of the BCPC, by rivering a Royal Flush.

DARREN RUMBOLD (28K) was starting to make his presence felt now and by the start of Level 8, he was 2nd only to **GARETH HOWARD** (30K) after taking out both **MANDEEP SINGH** & **ANDRE CROSSFIELD** on the same hand. Soon after **MATT KAY** was K/O'd by **ADAM PHELAN**, but minutes later a rivered set saw **GAZ** eliminate **ADAM** to take 46,700 chips onto the Final Table.

When we went down to 6 players **GAZ** had moved it up to 63k, which was 40% of the chips in play, but when **STEVE HEALEY** became the Bubble Boy by exiting in 4th, **GAZ**, **DAZ**, & **RICH HUGHES** all had very even stacks. The pivotal hand saw **DAZ** jam pocket 8's & **GAZ** make the call with K-J8 on the flop and **GAZ** is 3rd for £150.

So it was **DAZ** (99K) v **RICH** (66K) for the Title. A raise by **DAZ** was called by **RICH** and a 6-8-9 flop saw **DAZ** shove with **RICH** just covered. **RICH** eventually made the call and showed 9-4 to **DARREN'S** K-Q. Aces on the turn and river were no help, leaving **RICH** a 10/1 chippy. Soon afterwards, **RICH** (£386) completed the job, denying **DAZ** (£230) his 3rd Title in 5 months.



After not winning in his first 46 attempts, **RICH** is now the **BCPC 2023 Champion!**

DARREN TAKES DOWN HO-HO-HOMAHA 2023



After taking the PLO Super Summer Sizzler Title back in August (without winning a game!), **DARREN RUMBOLD** showed his continued love for the game of Omaha when he added the “HO-HO-HOMAHA” crown in our annual Christmas event.

EDDIE JUDGE came through the 16-man field to take £112 for 3rd place and **MARK ENGLAND** was denied his first ever BCPC Title as he picked up £167 for 2nd place but it was **DAZ** who took the £279 first prize and all of the PLO bragging rights until next summer!

ADAM JOINS THE CENTURIONS



ADAM PHELAN plays his 100th BCPC game tonight, becoming only the 6th player to join the “100 Club” alongside **BRIAN YATES** (157), **TOD WOOD** (143), **TONY TRIPPIER** (133), **PAUL FOY** (123) & **STEVE HEALEY** (117).

It has been a big year for **ADAM**, who was inducted into the BCPC Hall Of Fame in November 2022 and then followed up last summer with his biggest ever win of £12,000 in the “DTD 100”, after being backed by several BCPC members.

“When I finally got my first big win, my initial feeling was a pure release that I had finally got that monkey off my back and won an amazing tournament. It was also bittersweet though, as I didn’t have anyone there with me. I had my backers and friends congratulations, which was amazing, but wish I had someone I knew there in person I guess. In the future, I would love to go and play poker abroad in an EPT or WPT with Las Vegas the ultimate destination, where I one day hope to play in The Main Event!”.

ADAM is now in his 18th BCPC season, having first joined us for Season 8 in May 2011. After finishing 22nd in that debut campaign, he was then runner-up in back-to-back seasons and made the top 10 in 5 of his first 8 seasons. Following a year off, he triumphed immediately on his return by becoming Season 18 Champion.

He now has a record-equalling 9 matchnight wins to his name and is rated as one of the best Heads-Up players at the BCPC, holding a 9-2 record on Matchnights, plus 3 Heads-Up Champion Titles also.

ADAM has also scored points in every season he has so far played...except this one!....so maybe tonight is the night.

“I have been with the BCPC for many years now & I can honestly say that I would not be the player I am today without the help and advice received from the BCPC members. I have been on outings to many places throughout the UK & have thoroughly enjoyed each & every experience.

“Finally, my toughest opponent has to be **GARETH HOWARD**....his understanding and knowledge of the game, in my opinion, is the highest at the Club”.
