As things stand currently, the top 5 players are now all inductees into the BCPC Hall Of Fame, with **MANDEEP SINGH** sneaking up into 7th as he attempts to become the first player to successfully defend the BCPC Title.

WEEK THREE MILESTONES

MARK ENGLAND extended his Club Record of games without a *first* win to 69. He is now only 4 games from equalling **PAUL FOY**'s Club Record for *consecutive* games without a win of 73 games.

BRIAN YATES extended his record for most Final Tables to 78, while also regaining the "Biggest Loser" mantle from **PAUL FOY** of a **£558** career loss.

HITENDRA PATEL has now played 28 games without a cash which is the 3rd-worst streak ever & only 4 off **PAUL FOY**'s Club Record.

Both **DARREN RUMBOLD** & **ADAM PHELAN** collected their first points of the season & for **ADAM**, that makes it 18 consecutive scoring at least a point.

ANDY DUNCAN improved his Club-Record Final Table Percentage to 64.17% (43 of 67) & the 6 points collected for his 5th place finish takes his Average Per Season to 22.75, moving him past **NATHAN HARRIS** into the No.1 spot in that category.

MANDEEP SINGH made his 10th Final Table and so having won 3 of those, he moves past **LEE MASON** into the No.1 position for conversion rate (30.00%).

TOD WOOD extended his Club Record with his 34th career-cash.

The votes were counted and we now have our newest inductees into the BCPC Hall Of Fame.

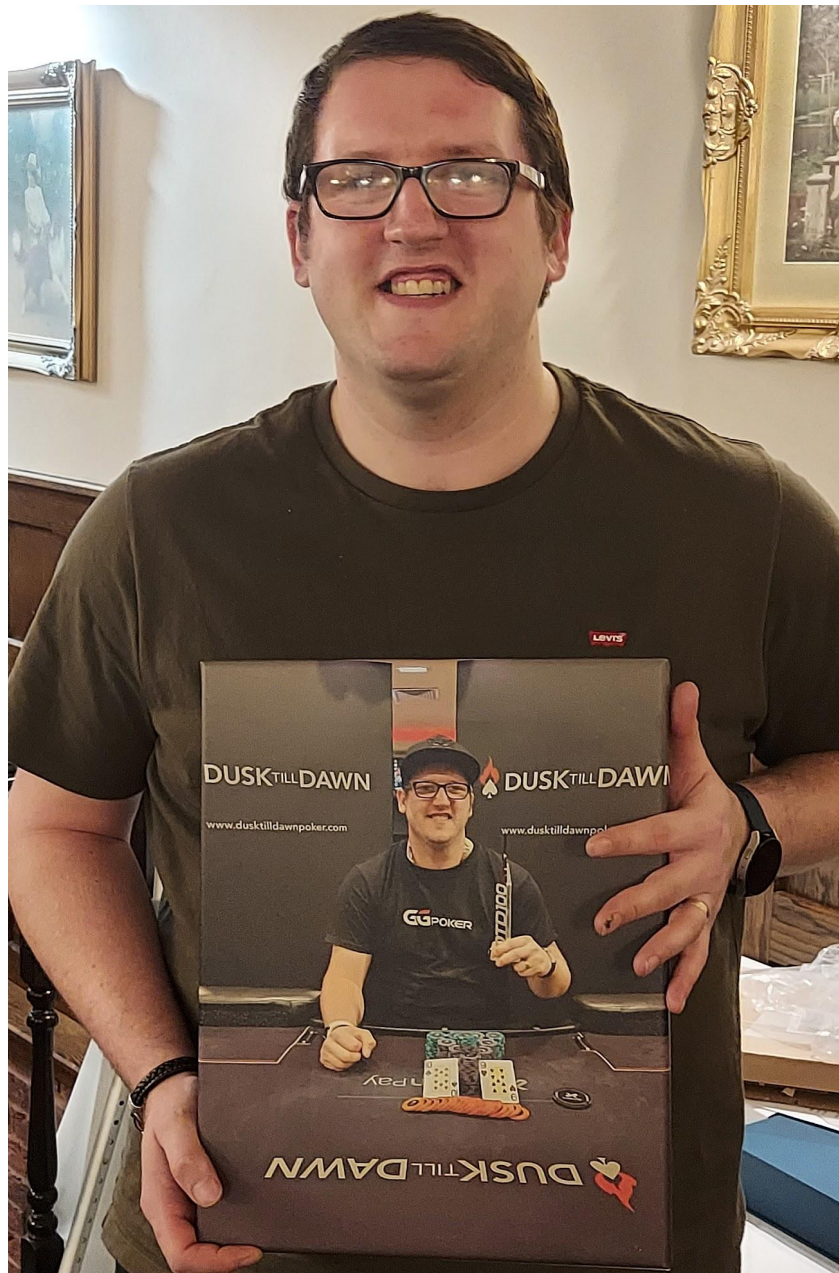

GAZ JOINS THE “100 CLUB”



He didn't join us until Season 11 in 2013 but today **GARETH HOWARD** becomes the 7th player to reach a Century of games at the BCPC.

“I delayed joining at first as I didn't see the value in it but I joined the next season and was hooked. From the players to the Committee, I was welcomed with open arms and felt part of a group that quickly became family and then a big part of my life”.

“From West Brom to Dublin to Las Vegas, many great laughs have been shared and many of my best memories, which I will never forget!”

Now in his 18th Season, he is still chasing that elusive first League win and amazingly, has won just two BCPC Titles, becoming Heads-Up Champion in Season 21 & on our victorious Champions League III team, though he did also win the Champions League IV, after defecting to Malvern!

He has scored points in all 18 of his BCPC seasons and has a top 3 finish in 13 of those. He also has 2 cashes while representing the Club, totalling £1120.

GAZ made his breakthrough on the National scene when in April 2017 he won the GUKPT Main Event in Walsall for £28,845, which really was a life-changing win for him.

“Many won’t know that I was in huge debt at that time due to a previous bad gambling addiction and the win gave me a fresh start. I said in an interview with Bluff Europe that these things don’t happen to people like me. I always thought that I was ok at poker, but not at a level to win something like that”.

GAZ is hoping that from here he can move his game onto the next level and become a Full-Time professional player.

“I want to start to build a name for myself in the bigger tournaments and get recognised for my true ability. I didn’t play much last year but will be aiming to get a few wins in 2024”

When asked who were his toughest BCPC opponents he gave several names....”I don’t think **RICKY** has reached anywhere near what he can be capable of and can see big scores coming. He has learnt a lot and at a quick rate. **LEE** hasn’t played enough big comps but has a good understanding of the game while I don’t think **EDDIE** knows what he is going to do in any given situation so how am I supposed to know?! **ADAM PHELAN** has come a long way and now he has a win under his belt, can hopefully push on and get a few more while **MANDEEP** has impressed me in his short time at the Club.....and you Old Boys (!) are all too stubborn!”

Always happy to give advice on the game, **GAZ** said “I would like to get our players to become better and maybe give them a new way of thinking and give them new lines to think of, etc..”

EXPIRED SEATS

All seats won at the BCPC, be they via league positions or BAPWAC's, etc... have a shelf life of two years, meaning that each winning player has two years in which to play that seat on a 50/50 basis. Should a player not be able to play in that time, they can nominate a player to play for them, or return the seat to the Club.

The Committee have now decided that moving on, any expired seats will be added (one per season) as a bounty prize during Week 4. Therefore, tonight's game will include the £300 seat won by **JAKE POXON** for finishing 2nd in our "Lockdown League" during Covid. As **JAKE** requested that someone should play his seat for him, then whoever draws this as a Bounty would split any winnings on a 25/25 basis with Jake and 50% going to the players who played in the Lockdown League.

For Season 29, **ANEURIN VENABLES'** £225 seat won in Season 22 will be added and played on the same basis as above. Season 30 will see **KEV MCAULEY's** £125 seat from Season 22 played on a 50/50 basis as this was allowed to expire without prior notification from the player.

As for forthcoming Season 24 seats that are set to expire on APRIL 30TH, we have **DAVE WHITELEY** (£200), **JACK WARBURTON** (£150) & **PAUL FOY** (£150). **DAVE** will be playing his in the Walsall 25/50 next week with **BRIAN YATES** also using his £200 seat from Season 26 in that comp.
