WEEK ONE MILESTONES

AMY COSHAN made it 7 consecutive Final Tables, the best current streak, but still a long way off **TOD WOOD**'s Club Record of 11.

ADAM PHELAN lost his 2nd Heads-Up battle in the last 3 games, moving his record to 10-4 (71.42%), meaning he slips to 2nd place in the All-Time list behind **STEVE REDFERN** (8-3, 72.72%). After collecting a total of £107.50 though, he did move past **MATT KAY** into 3rd in the All-Time list for highest profit (+£586).

DAVE WHITELEY ended his long streak of games without a cash at 22 with his 5th place finish (£40.50). This leaves **TONY GRIFFITHS** on the longest current streak of 15.

STEVE HEALEY finished 3rd, meaning he has now picked up points in each of his 22 seasons, just one short of **BRIAN YATES**'s record of 23.

MATT JUDGE now has the outright (81st) worst Final Table % at 13.04% (3 of 23).

BRIAN YATES finished 4th to extend his Club Record for Most Final Tables Made to 80.

ALEX BOLTON was the only player in Week 1 who didn't play in Season 28. He returned to the Club after a season off, only to be the first player eliminated, giving him both the Shirt Of Shame and the Cap Of Crap for the first time!

WILL YOUNG WINS SUMMER DEEPSTACK XIV



Season 24 Champion **WILL YOUNG** added the Deepstack Title to his BCPC CV on the first day of Summer 24 as he took down Deepstack XIV for a record score of £1200.

The tournament, sporting a new structure, broke all records, with 39 runners, 39 re-buys and 72 add-ons giving us a massive £4795 prizepool. 22 players had at least one re-buy, although **LIAM PICKERING & NIC RAWLINGS** were a little more active, sporting FIVE re-buys each!

SIMON PENDLEBURY was the first casualty, followed quickly by **DALE MACCHIARELLI** which took us down to 36 players, causing a break as we went down to 4 tables. 5 minutes later, in walks **NIC CROSS** for a late cash entry to a chorus of boos, as we then had to break again to move back up to 5 tables....lesson learned there by the TD!!

WILL was also a pre-paid late arrival but just 3 hands in his flopped set of 6's was crushed by a flopped set of J's and so it was a quick re-buy for him.

After around 10 hours of play, we were down to the last 10 players & when **DAVE HALLIDAY** (£130) shoved all-in, shortstack **CRAIG STANDEN** (£75) made the call, only for **WILL** to re-shove, table AA and take both of them out.

So 8-handed at the final table we had 2.8 million chips in play with 2023 runner-up **MARK POWELL** leading the way on 537k. First-time player NATHAN WALLAGE had 434k with **WILL** on 422k. **RICH HUGHES** and **GAZ HOWARD** both had around 375k with **LIAM** on 311k while the shortstacks were **DAVE WHITELEY** (213K) & **TOM MANSELL** (137k).

Needing to finish 5th to cover his costs for the day, **LIAM** (£190) was first to leave courtesy of **RICH** before **GAZ** took out **DAVE** (£250) in 7th. Currently in great form, **GAZ** was now the man to beat but then he picked up KK in the SB, only for **MARK** to table AA in the big, leaving **GAZ** crushed & soon after he exited in 6th place (£350).

TOM had done well to move his short stack into 5th place before being taken out (£450) and then **RICH** (£550) was out in 4th. This meant the top 3 starting stacks would finish top 3 and as the clock ticked towards 2am, we lost NATHAN in 3rd for £700.

The Heads-Up battle was swift & after re-buying early doors with a flopped set of 6's, it was that same 6-6 that would hold for **WILL** against **MARK'S** (£900) A-J to give him the Title & £1200, plus his entry in to the "Battle Of The Champions" in January 2025.
