WEEK TWO MILESTONES

SHANE LENTON picked up his first career win & in doing so became the 48th different player to top the table. His total of 19 points means that this is already his best-ever season.

MARK ENGLAND has now gone 72 games without getting his first win but if he fails to win tonight, he will also equal **PAUL FOY**'s All-Time record of 73 consecutive games without a win at any time.

BRIAN YATES picked up 10 points for 3rd which makes him only the 2nd player to go past 500 career points but his 507 total now moves him past **TOD WOOD** making him the top points-scorer of All-Time. He also extended his Club Record for Most Final Tables Made to 81.

MATT MCKINLAY finished 2nd, meaning he has now picked up points in each of his 20 seasons, the 3rd best streak of All-Time. This also was his 15th time Heads-Up, 2nd only to **TOD WOOD** who has 18.

MANDEEP SINGH has now held the No.1 Ranking spot for 11 games, which equals the 2nd-best streak ever, behind **STEVE REDFERN**'s 14.

HITENDRA PATEL made his 4th consecutive Final Table.
