## **WEEK 1 MILESTONES**

Victory for **LEE MASON** ended his longest ever run of games without a win at 16, while **CHARLES MASON** is now on his worst career run after reaching 19. **MARK ENGLAND** is still extending his All-Time records, which now stand at 77 games, while **LIAM PICKERING** became just the 7th player to have reached 50 games since winning his last one.

**LEE MASON** also equalled his total points (15) for last season while his record haul of **£333.50** saw him almost double his career-profit (£651), leaping into 3rd All-Time & now sitting 2nd on profit per game (£12.87) behind only **ADAM SHARPLES** (£19.11). **LEE** is the first-ever two-time Bounty game winner and is also now 2nd in Final Table conversion percentage, having won 5 of his 19 attempts (26.31%), with only **DAVE HALLIDAY** (4 of 10, 40.00%) ahead of him.

**MATT MCKINLAY** cashed for the 23rd time in a BCPC League game, moving him past **ADAM PHELAN** into 5th place.

**EDDIE JUDGE** became only the 12th player to cash in 3 consecutive BCPC League games and if he can do so again tonight, he will equal the Club Record of 4, which was last posted NINE YEARS ago, and is held by **TOD WOOD & LAURA RHODEN**.

**ALEX BOLTON** remains bottom in Final Table percentage, having made just one from his 13 games (7.69%).
