WEEK 2 MILESTONES

It looked for all the World in Week 2 that **LAURA RHODEN** was going to end her 58-game streak without a win but she eventually had to settle for 2nd place. That meant that at 59 games, that streak remains as the 3rd-longest ever without a win behind **MARK ENGLAND** (78) & **PAUL FOY** (73). **LAURA** did end one other Club Record streak though as her run of Season's Without A Top 3 Finish was ended at 9. **LIAM PICKERING & MATT JUDGE** now hold the current longest active streaks with 6 seasons, including this one. **LAURA** also now has double-figure points in a season for the first time since Season 19.

NICK TATTON made his first ever Final Table & scored his first BCPC points with his 5th place finish while **GAZ HOWARD'S** 4th place saw him maintain his No.1 ranking & reach 20 consecutive season's scoring at least one point, which is every season he has played!

HITENDRA PATEL now has the worst-ever (47th) Final Table conversion percentage, having won just once from his 27 Final Tables made (3.7%) for those having reached a minimum of 10. He also joins **DARREN HOOPER, JAY SCOTT, ANDY DUNCAN, RICHARD HUGHES & ADAM SMITH** on 20 consecutive Final Tables without a win, which is the equal-3rd-worst streak ever behind **MARK ENGLAND** (31) & **MATT WILSON** (23).

ALEX BOLTON finished 28th & therefore remains bottom in Final Table percentage, having made just one from his 14 games played (7.14%).

HO-HO-HOMAHA



19 attempts without a win in Regular-Season BCPC games but for **NIC CROSS**, winning the other games has become a habit as he became the 6th most successful BCPC player ever by taking down his 8th career-title with victory in the 2024 “Ho-Ho-Homaha” in December. This meant he became the first ever two-time winner of this Title and also added to wins in the Omaha classic in 2016 and the PLO Super Summer Sizzler title in 2019.

NIC collected £373 plus the trophies for victory, with 2024 Sizzler Champion **CRAIG STANDEN** 2nd for £224 & 2023 Ho-Ho-Homaha Champion **DARREN RUMBOLD** back in 3rd for £149 from the field of 18 runners, making it a decent night for these Omaha specialists.

HIGH-HAND POT

Tonight is our last “EPT 25” BAPWAC sheet. The winner will receive 13,000 chips (£260 worth) into our EPT comp on **FEBRUARY 7TH @ 7.00PM**, the winner of which will receive a £5000 EPT package, which includes the E5300 (£4447) entry fee with the rest going towards travel and hotel expenses. This can be used at ANY EPT but must be used on or before the end of FEBRUARY 2027. If not, the prize will return to the BCPC to give out as we see fit.

As you can see above, there is already £5540 in the prizepool and with the BAPWAC sheet, plus tonight’s “Last-Longer” to add, this will give us £5960 prior to the tournament. On the day of the event, players can purchase ANY amount of chips at ANY time, up until the end of Level 6, when we will stop taking entries and re-buys. Cost of chips is £10 per 500.

There are EPT side events at E2200 (£1846), E1100 (£923) & E550 (£462) & once we know the full prizepool, we will be adding 2nd & hopefully 3rd place prizes to the payouts.

This event is open to ANY PLAYERS, not just to BCPC members but please let us know if you do intend playing, as it will help me to sort out the table draw.

Currently, we have just 8 players entered, with one more confirmed to buy-in on the night..

EPT's announced so far for 2025 are Monte Carlo in April & Barcelona in August. Paris in February has been cancelled.

Day one will consist of 10 x 40-minute levels, with blinds starting at 100/200, and will finish around 2.05am, with the date for Day 2 to be decided when we know who is left in, although **FEBRUARY 14TH** is the provisional date for this.

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS MEMORIAL GAME 2024



We had a record 20 qualifiers for this event and with an extra 2k on the starting stacks, we had not lost a player by Level 4. Late arrival **LIAM PICKERING** came in, played 2 hands and “BOOM”...**LEE MASON** made him the night’s first casualty before next hand **NIC RAWLINGS** was seen off by **NIC CROSS**.

2023 Player Of The Year **RICHARD HUGHES** relinquished his Title when **TONY GRIFFITHS** eliminated him in 17th & when **SHANE LENTON** exited in 13th, we had the unusual situation whereby the 8 players eliminated had all been ousted by a different person.

PAUL GONKO’s 12th place exit was another unusual one as **ADAM SMITH** AND **ADAM PHELAN** both took him out as they split the pot. When reigning BCPC Champion **STEVE HEALEY** left in 9th place, knocked-out by **LEE MASON**, the Final Table was set, with **LEE** a big chip-leader on 63,800 followed by **TONY.G** on 26,000 & **ADAM PHELAN** on 25,200 with **TREVOR DUNN** (16,400), **BRIAN YATES** (12,900) & **CRAIG STANDEN** (12,600) bringing up the rear.

LEE had earlier won a monster pot with his 7-4 flopping trips & rivering quads to bust **TREV**'s Aces & he made sure **TREV** was finished off by eliminating him in 8th place. **GARETH HOWARD** saw off **TONY** in 7th before we had the controversial play of the night as **BRI** (K-K) inexplicably slow-rolled **CRAIG**'s 3-bet Jam, after enquiring "How big is your Ace?", putting him out in 6th.

LEE had been worn down on the Final Table, folding several times to 3-bets and shoves, which seemed to affect him as his stack dwindled and finally, **GAZ** made him the Bubble-Boy.

That meant that Short-Stack **ADAM SMITH** had limped into the money but after earlier doubling him up, **BRI** saw him off in 4th for £79.50. **ADAM.P** was now the shorty but his double with J-9 Vs **BRI**'s A-Q flipped that around and when **BRI** jammed, **ADAM** called after seeing one K....ironically, he had a 2nd one too, which I guess was some sort of Karma!...**BRI** taking home £157.

So that left Season 28, Week 3 winner **ADAM PHELAN** Vs Season 28 Champion **GARETH HOWARD** & it was our No.1 ranked player **GAZ** (£314) who took the Title of "BCPC 2024 Player Of The Year" as his K-J turned 2-pair Vs **ADAM**'s (£235) pocket Queens.
