WEEK 3 MILESTONES

LAURA RHODEN became only the 3rd player ever to have a streak of 60 games without a win, alongside **MARK ENGLAND** (79) & **PAUL FOY** (73).

DAVE HALLIDAY went past 100 career points as he won his 5th career game & also became the oldest player to ever win a BCPC League game. His average of 22.80 points per season is now the best ever, moving past **ANDY DUNCAN** (22.75) & his average profit per game of £13.89 is 2nd only to **ADAM SHARPLES** (£19.11).

DAVE also extended his Club Record conversion percentage on Final Tables to an amazing 45.45%, having now won 5 of the 11 that he has made while at the other end of the spectrum, **HITENDRA PATEL** remains last (46th) on conversion percentage at 3.57% (1 of 28) with his current streak of 21 without a win being the 3rd-worst ever behind **MARK ENGLAND** (31) & **MATT WILSON** (23).

ADAM PHELAN was runner-up in Week 3 to just miss out on what would have been a Club-Record 11th win but his 23rd career cash now ties him for 6th all-time with **MATT MCKINLAY** & also moves him up to 4th on All-Time Profit at £598. It also gives him 20 consecutive seasons scoring a point.

GARETH HOWARD produced a “Cap Of Crap” performance that saw the BCPC 2024 Player Of The Year out first for a record 9th time!

HIGH-HAND POT

Tonight’s High-Hand pot stands at approximately **£129** for anyone getting QUAD JACKS or better.

BCPC EPT 25

On Friday February 7th, 9 players sat down to contest our “EPT 25” game, which began with £6160 in the prizepool, with a £5000 EPT Main Event package guaranteed for the winner. This had been generated by events such as Last-Longers, where the winner got a prize of chips into this competition instead of actual cash.

MANDEEP SINGH began the night with a chipstack of 73,000, which was 23% of the chips in play (365 bb's), with **MATT MCKINLAY** 2nd on 56,500. **TOM CAWLEY** was the shortstack, having won 13,000 chips in our final “BAPWAC 25” for just £10 at the Week 3 game....the only money he had put into the pot! He was quickly all-in, flopping a straight on an 8c-6h-4h board, with **TOD WOOD** making a call with the nut-flush draw and getting there on the river, eliminating **TOM** in 9th.

LIAM PICKERING followed in 8th soon after with **TOD** going in 7th, only to rebuy 25,000 chips for £500.

CHARLES MASON was getting low & decided to add 15,000 to his stack for £300 & then just before the end of the rebuy period in Level 6, **BRIAN YATES** (AK) made the call after **MATT MCKINLAY** 4-bet jammed with AQ and with 100,000 in the pot, a Q on the flop put paid to **BRIAN'S** hopes of EPT glory.

The final hand before the break was brutal. On a flop of Ad Qs Jc, **CHARLES** calls **MATT'S** bet & when the Qd hits the turn, **CHARLES** (KsQh) calls **MATT'S** All-In jam, only to find **MATT** holding AsAh!! **CHARLES** literally has 1 card to keep him in the comp...& down comes the Qc!!!! **CHARLES** takes the chip lead on 112,000 into the break with **MATT** down to 25,000. **RICKY** is also on just 14 big-blinds (16,700) while Dealer **ADAM PHELAN** decided he would enter the fray after the break, entering with 20,000 (17 bb's) chips for £400, which gave us a magnificent total prizepool of £7360.

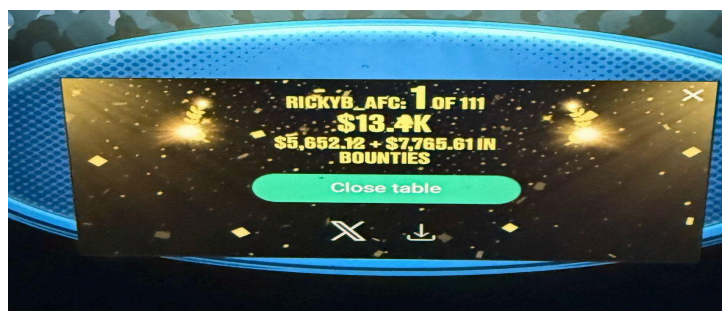
This meant an £1110 seat for 3rd and a GUKPT Main Event seat for the runner-up & on the restart, **RICKY** doubled up when his 66 held vs AsKs before **CHARLES** then saw off **TOD** as AK suited again came a cropper. **ADAM** got the double-up he was looking for when hitting runner-runner flush vs **CHARLES'S** 9-9 but **CHARLES** then pulled a lot back, putting **ADAM** into the tank before he had to fold and a few hands later, **MATT** took **ADAM** out to leave us with 5 players.

STEVE was eliminated in 5th spot to take us to the bubble, where **MATT** moved All-In with 10-10, called by **MANDEEP'S** AQ.....& a rivered Q saw **MATT** exit, putting both **MANDEEP** and **CHARLES** on 150,000, with **RICKY** back on 67,000.

MANDEEP quickly took a big pot off **CHARLES** to leap to 200k before **CHARLES** ousted **RICKY** in 3rd place, taking us to the last level of the night with **MANDEEP** on 235k and **CHARLES** on 131k.

MANDEEP took another 90k pot in the final level before ending Day One with a monster chip-lead of 346,000 to **CHARLES'S** 22,000, which will equate to 7 Big-Blinds when play recommences tonight with the winner receiving the £5000 EPT package and the runner-up a £1250 GUKPT seat.

RICKY TRIUMPHS ON POKERSTARS



A massive CONGRATULATIONS to **RICKY BUCKLAND**, who last Saturday satellited into the \$530 “6-Max Bounty Builder” game on Pokerstars for \$55.....& only went and won it for \$13,417....possibly a WSOP Main Event entry for \$55 there Ricky??

KEVIN BERRIE JOINS THE “100 CLUB”



He joined us in Season 13 in November 2014 & after playing every season since then, tonight **KEVIN BERRIE** becomes the 10th player to join the BCPC “100-Club” as he makes his 100th career appearance.

One of the most likeable players at the BCPC, **KEV** has never quite managed to lift the League Title, with runner-up in Season 27 being the best of his 6 top-ten finishes.

He has 4 career wins to his name plus three 2nds & three 3rds but he is now the only member of that “100-Club” not to lift a Title of any kind in Club history..... time to put this right **KEV!**

Despite that blip, both players were superb in making the Final Table of 9 & team-play was observed until we got down to 7, where the team clinched 3rd spot and the £5600 that accompanied it. A debutant in this tournament, **EDDIE** was chip-leader but an ill-timed shove with 8-8 on a 10-high board was met with J-J to put him back into the pack & ironically, **BRIAN** then took him out in 6th for £600 before himself exiting in 5th place for £700.

Also on the Sunday, **ADAM PHELAN** added £2000 to his weekend's work by chopping the NLHE/PLO Round Of Each game, making it a very successful trip all round 😊

A GREAT CASH FOR EDDIE



EDDIE JUDGE played the recent UKPC Opener at DTD for the BCPC and had a magnificent first day, absolutely smashing it to take 1.23 million chips into Day 2, putting him 3rd overall. He eventually finished 31st for £700, giving him his first BCPC cash and also making him, at 76 years & 255 days, the oldest player ever to do this.
