WEEK 3 MILESTONES

BRIAN YATES finished in 3rd place for the 10th time, equalling the Club Record held by **TONY TRIPPIER**. He also extended his Club Record for Most Points Scored to 548 & joined **GARETH HOWARD** in 4th place All-Time with 28 career cashes.

MATT KAY is now equal-6th All-Time with **TONY TRIPPIER** after reaching his 14th Heads-Up & is up from 6th to 3rd with a profit of **£614.50**, behind only **GARETH HOWARD (£914.75)** & **TOD WOOD (£682.50)**.

LIAM PICKERING was first out for the 8th time, second only to **GAZ HOWARD** (9) & that also puts him equal 2nd with **LAURA RHODEN** & **TONY GRIFFITHS** who have also worn the Shirt Of Shame on 7 occasions with **TONY TRIPPIER** holding that record at 8.

AMY COSHAN became the 9th player to go 50 or more consecutive games without a win. **LIAM PICKERING** (58) & **HITENDRA PATEL** (55) are current players also on a long barren run with “H” now equalling the 2nd worst run of Consecutive Final Tables made without a win as he joins **MATT WILSON** on 23, chasing **MARK ENGLAND**’s record of 32.

After making a 5th consecutive Final Table, **SHANE LENTON** leads the League at the half-way point on 21 points, which is his best-ever tally for a whole season, as is **DANNY SHEPPARD**’s 6 points.

STEVE HOWELL picked up his first career points and made his first Final Table, while **MATT MCKINLAY** made it 22 consecutive seasons scoring a point, one off the record of 23 held by **STEVE HEALEY** & **BRIAN YATES**, although **STEVE** has yet to score a point this season so far to extend that record to 24.

AMANDA SMITH played her 10th career game and in doing so, replaced **ALEX BOLTON** in 84th (last) place for highest average loss per game at **£14.50** (10 @ **£145**).

BCPC WPT 27

We currently have £1450 in the prizepool for our “WPT 27” event, which will send someone to play a World Poker Tour event of their choosing in 2027/28, anywhere in the World. Each 500 chips cost £10 and here are the current chipcounts (80,000 chips in play)....

1- GARETH HOWARD 20,000 2- BRIAN YATES 12,500 3= NIC RAWLINGS 10,500, TOM CAWLEY 10,500 5- MANDEEP SINGH 7000 6= DARREN RUMBOLD, MATT JUDGE, RICKY BUCKLAND 6500.

At each game, we run a BAPWAC which costs £5 and the winner gets 6500 chips. We also run a “Last Longer” costing £20, which pays 1000 chips for each player entered, with a bonus of 2500 extra chips if you go on and win that night, which **BRI, NIC & TOM** have all done this year.

Everybody who pays into either of these events at any time, will qualify for a % of the winner(s) when they play in the WPT....the more you have put in, the bigger the % you could potentially get out.

Hopefully, the first prize will be in the region of £5000, to include expenses for hotel and flights if required, with a 2nd and possibly 3rd prize if the prizepool allows for this. These will be decided once we have a final total in early 2027.

BCPC SUMMER DEEPSTACK XV

The 15th running of our annual Summer Deepstack was almost certainly the hottest game that the BCPC have ever run as we toiled in 33-degree heat outside, and possibly even warmer inside, as we played for the first time at the Park Inn in Woodsetton.

The numbers were slightly down on the previous two years, but were still good as 31 players sat down at 12.30, although our 21-year-old computer finally gave up the ghost, causing us to run the tournament manually throughout.

By the end of Level 7, we had seen 34 rebuys, with **TONY TRIPPIER & NATE POULTON** leading the charge with 4 each, and with the addition of 60 add-ons, that gave us a prizepool of **£3834.50**.

It was **AMANDA SMITH** who was first to leave us early in Level 8, followed by Charlie Higgins and then **MATT & EDDIE JUDGE**, although **EDDIE** would then draw the eventual winner in the sweep to take home a **£70** consolation prize! **GAZ HOWARD** led the way at this stage on 158k with **PETER CAREY** on 135k, **RICKY BUCKLAND** on 132k & **TREVOR DUNN** on 131k but **TREV** then exited soon after in 27th while **GAZ** would fall just short of the Final Table in 11th place.

With 8 players paid and a 9-handed Final Table, a saver was offered but could not be agreed on by all 9 players and that meant that **STEVE HEALEY**'s exit in 9th left him with nothing to show for around 9-hours of toil in the heat.

RICKY BUCKLAND (**£100**) & **NIC RAWLINGS** (**£175**) both made their first ever cashes in this event before **TONY GRIFFITHS** (**£275**) went in 6th, equalling the record with his 4th cash in this event.

DARREN RUMBOLD's deep run ended with **£380** in 5th before **WILL YOUNG**'s great attempt at retaining the trophy was halted in 4th for **£500**, making him the most successful player ever with a total of **£1875** won from 3 cashes.

Down to the final three and it was BCPC No.1 ranked player **DAVE HALLIDAY** who was next out, taking home **£629** and that left **DANNY SHEPPARD & PETER CAREY** to battle it out...



....and after a short Heads-Up it was **PETE CAREY** who took the Title, winning **£1000** plus the trophy, a tankard to keep & a place in the 2025 Champion Of Champions event in January. **DANNY** took home **£775** for his runner-up prize.

The tournament was another massive success and Stu told us that he had "A great day", meaning that we will be welcome to host further events there in the future, starting with Champions League IX in October.

BCPC PLO SUPER SUMMER SIZZLER SERIES 2025

Victory in Game Two of our 2025 Series went to 2023 Champion **DARREN RUMBOLD** (£140) as he defeated 2024 Champion **CRAIG STANDEN** (£85) with **ADAM PHELAN** (£50) back in 3rd place.

With **CRAIG** already having a 1st and 2nd place to his name, there are only 3 players who can stop him from retaining the Title in the final game of 2025.....**DARREN** needs 6th place or better, **MATT MCKINLAY** requires minimum 2nd while **ALEX BOLTON** has to win. If **CRAIG** gets 10th he eliminates **ALEX**, 7th would eliminate **MATT** while 2nd means he could not be caught by **DARREN**.
