WEEK 4 MILESTONES

BRIAN YATES finished in 7th place to extend his Club Record for Most Points Scored to 552 & this added to his records for Most Final Tables Made (88) & Games Played (177).

MATT KAY went from First in Week 3, to worst in Week 4 as he went out first for only the second time in his 69 career games, earning himself the Cap Of Crap this week while **TREVOR DUNN** captured the Shirt Of Shame for the first time ever.

DAWN WILSON made her first Top 3 finish since Season 10, way back in 2013, thus ending a 27-game run without a cash.

DANNY SHEPPARD moved onto 9 points, continuing his best-ever BCPC Season in an upward direction.

STEVE HEALEY finished 9th for 2 points and that now gives him the record outright for Consecutive Seasons Scoring A Point at 24.

Congratulations to **JOEY WILLIAMS**, who won an emotional victory in our annual BCPC “Ant Williams Memorial Golf Day”, named after his Brother and fellow BCPC player, **ANT. JOEY** beat 3 players including **TOD WOOD**, by just a single point, to claim the trophy for the first time ever.

BCPC CROWN A NEW WORLD CHAMPION !

At the recent APAT WCOAP series in Nottingham, our very own **CHARLES MASON** became the first BCPC player to become a double-World Champion, after he took down the Fixed Limit Mixed Draw Title, almost 16 years to the day after lifting the No Limit Hold-Em World Title at the same venue. For this one though, he received a much-coveted APAT bracelet joining **STEVE REDFERN**, **TONY TRIPPIER** & **RICKY BUCKLAND** in holding the Title of World Champion.



“My first cash of the series was 4th place in the 8-game, where I was able to duck and dive to the Day 2 Final Table. The Final was very swingy and I quickly took the chip-lead, but literally anyone could have gone out on any hand. Overall, I was happy with 4th place for **£1185** but badly wanted a medal”

“I entered the Fixed Limit Mixed Game with literally no experience of 5-card Draw High or Courcheval Hi-Lo, but two tables out I had an unreal run of cards and started to boss the table. Playing Razz & 2-7 Triple Draw, I was able to represent a lot of strong hands, irrespective of my holdings and on the Final Table, was able to do similar with the money and ICM pressure. It was great to clinch the win, gold medal, my first bracelet and **£2110**, although I just missed out on the “Player Of The Series” Title, finishing in 3rd”.

Also cashing at the WCOAP was **STEVE HEALEY**, who took his BAPWAC seat onto the Final Table of the PLO 4/5/6 and into 8th place, winning **£350**, of which **DARREN RUMBOLD, MATT JUDGE & BRIAN YATES** all get **£35**. This was the 2nd BAPWAC cash since we began the idea, following in the footsteps of **ROB HEWLITT** in 2023.

ANDY DUNCAN also came along with his obligatory APAT results as he finished 64th in the Main Event for **£350** & then was then 10th in the PLO8 for **£285**, giving him an incredible 27 lifetime APAT cashes, while **NIC RAWLINGS** came 10th in the TORSE event for **£225**.

Also, nice wins on PokerStars for **RORY FORD** (**\$601**) on Friday & **RICKY BUCKLAND** (**\$1880**) last Saturday & talking of Stars, **BRIAN YATES** finally received his SCOOP trophy last week 😊
