WEEK 1 MILESTONES

CHARLES MASON was certainly the Man Of The Moment in Week One. His first victory in 25 games ended the worst run of his long BCPC Career & also took him up into 19th place as he became the 19th player to move past 200 career points.

He now leads the League for only the 3rd time in 85 games but his win over **ROB HEWLITT** means he has now lost just 1 of his 8 Heads-Up battles over his 23 Seasons.

His Final Table conversion rate of 7 from 28 (25.00%) is second only to **DAVE HALLIDAY** (38.46%) while he also becomes the SIXTH different player to receive an extra 2500 chips in our WPT25 “Last-Longer” by also going onto win.

HITENDRA PATEL now has no wins from his last 26 Final Table appearances, second All-Time behind **MARK ENGLAND** (32), although “**H**” did become the 20th player to go past 200 career points.

LAURA RHODEN made it 64 games since her last win, the 3rd-worst streak ever, though still a long way shy of **MARK ENGLAND**’s 81, while both **EDDIE JUDGE** & **DAVE WHITELEY** joined **RICHARD HUGHES** on 46 games without getting their FIRST career win for the 3rd-worst streak All-Time.
