HAPPY NEW YEAR FROM THE BCPC

WEEK 2 MILESTONES

AMY COSHAN ended her worst-ever losing streak at 54 games with victory in Week 2, her first success since Week 6 of Season 20. This also gave her entry into the “Battle Of The Champions” for the first time ever, joining fellow first-timers **MARK ENGLAND, TOM CAWLEY, PETER CAREY, DAVE WHITELEY & DARREN O’NEILL**.

SHANE LENTON (2) & **DAWN WILSON** (18) both reached their highest-ever ranking following Week 2.

HITENDRA PATEL became just the 4th player ever to have a streak of 60 games without a win. He trails **MARK ENGLAND** (81), **PAUL FOY** (73) & **LAURA RHODEN** (64).

EDDIE JUDGE & DAVE WHITELEY have now gone 47 games without gaining their FIRST win giving them the 3rd worst streak ever, behind **MARK ENGLAND** (81) & **JAKE POXON**(56)

DARREN RUMBOLD now has the longest active streak of games without cashing at 23, with **RICHARD HUGHES** back on 19, both still a way off **PAUL FOY**’s record of 32.

BRIAN YATES extended his record points total to 539 & his record for most Final Tables to 90.

HO-HO-HOMAHA

Our biggest Ho-Ho-Homaha since it began took place on December 19th with 25 players turning out to create a prizepool of **£970** and, following a change to the regular structure, a record late-finish of 3:52am!



TONY TRIPPIER was the first casualty, taken out by reigning Champion **NIC CROSS** & he would take out **EDDIE JUDGE** (20th), **DAVE WHITELEY** (18th) & **ALEX BOLTON** (14th) en-route to yet another Final Table.

ANDY DUNCAN was another player on form as he accounted for **JAY SCOTT** (22nd), **TOD WOOD** (19th) & **NIC RAWLINGS** (12th) as he marched on to the final eight.

DI FARRELL became the first to exit the Final Table, at the hands of pre-Covid Champion **YVETTE SCOTT** with **JACK HIPKISS** out 7th to **STEVE HEALEY**.

CHARLES MASON then got busy, accounting for both **ANDY** and **MATT JUDGE** before collecting **£100** in 4th place, taken out by **NIC CROSS**, with both players having exactly the same chipstack.

It was a tense affair 3 -handed but **YVETTE** became **NIC**'s 6th victim of the night, exiting in 3rd for **£190**.

Could **NIC** retain the Title & become the first ever three-time Champ?.....

Well **STEVE HEALEY** had other ideas and despite only taking out one player all night, **NIC (£290)** became his second victim as he won his 13th BCPC Title & Battle Of The Champions entry, plus **£390**.

BATTLE OF THE CHAMPIONS MEMORIAL GAME 2025

It was a record field of 23 players who played out the now traditional opening BCPC game of the year on January 2nd, which would also have been **DAN RYDER**'s 37th Birthday, had he not been so cruelly taken by cancer in 2025.

With his name now etched on the trophy base, we raised a glass in his memory before getting underway & the first victim of 2026 was **DARREN RUMBOLD**, who fell to last year's runner-up **ADAM PHELAN**. **AMY COSHAN** was a first-timer in this event after winning December's league game but she went in 22nd to fellow debutant **DAVE WHITELEY** & by the time we went down to 2 tables at 16, 7 different players had taken out the 7 exiting players.

That all changed when **NIC RAWLINGS** took out both **LIAM PICKERING** (16th) and defending Champion **GARETH HOWARD** (15th) in quick succession to grab the Chip-Lead away from **MATT MCKINLAY**, before **DAVE WHITELEY** saw off both **CHARLES MASON** (13th) & **ADAM PHELAN** (12th) in the same hand.

BRIAN YATES was fighting back after being the shortstack with 16 left & he spiked a King to eliminate Season 31 Champ **SHANE LENTON** (AQ) in 12th & we then lost **TOM CAWLEY**, **MANDEEP SINGH** & **MATT MCKINLAY**, to give us our final table of 8.

Three of those eight were there for the second successive year, one being **TREVOR DUNN**, who emulated his 2024 position as **DAVE HALLIDAY** eliminated him in 8th place.

NIC RAWLINGS then took **CRAIG STANDEN** out in 7th before the only non-BCPC player in the field, OPL Champion **DARREN O'NEILL**, saw off **KEV BERRIE** in 6th, quickly followed by BCPC No.1 **DAVE HALLIDAY** (Ah10h) on the money-bubble, with a well-disguised QQ.

So we moved into the money and **BRIAN YATES** took control of the game, getting a run of big hands at just the right time. He sent **DARREN** (£100) back home to Northampton in 4th before seeing **NIC** (£180) off in 3rd to take a big chip-lead into the Heads-Up.

DAVE WHITELEY had lost both the Season 29 & Season 31 League Titles on the final hand of the season....had his time finally come? Well when he looked down at AcJc on the first hand of Heads-Up, he was hoping it had, but **BRI** insta-called (no slow-roll this year!!) with two black kings and with no help from the deck, **DAVE** finished 2nd for £270, with **BRI** (£400) crowned Champion Of Champions and the BCPC Player Of The Year for 2025!
