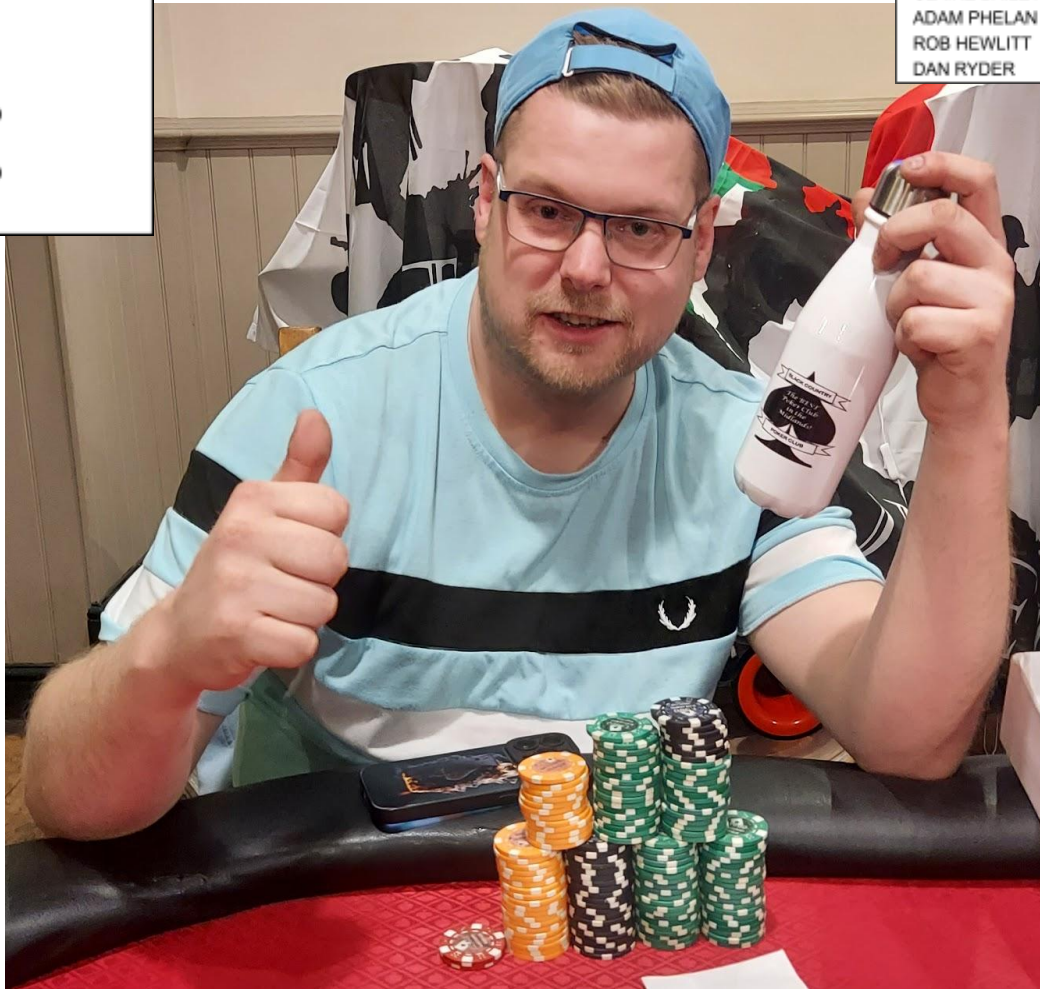

HIGH-HAND POT

Tonight's High-Hand pot stands at approximately **£130** for anyone getting QUAD JACKS or better. If you are the first to hit a qualifying hand, you get 75% of this figure, with 25% carrying over to the next pot.

WEEK 4 MILESTONES

GARETH HOWARD contested his 17th Heads-Up to move joint-2nd with **MATT MCKINLAY**. Only **TOD WOOD** (18) has now played more. **GAZ**'s 8th career-win moved him into equal-4th place alongside **TONY TRIPPIER** & **STEVE REDFERN** for games won, while his 29th career-cash puts him joint-3rd with **BRIAN YATES** & **TONY TRIPPIER**.

GAZ's win gave him his first points of Season 32 to give him a 22nd straight season scoring at least one point. **MATT MCKINLAY** also sits on 22 seasons, with **STEVE HEALEY** holding the record at 24. All three players have scored in every season they have played in, but both **STEVE** & **MATT**'s records are in jeopardy, as neither has yet registered a point in Season 32. His victory also means that **GAZ** now has a 7th successive season with his points in double-figures & 11 in his last 12.

DAVE WHITELEY may have gone past 100 career-points but he was once again the 'Bridesmaid' in Week 4 & his 0-4 record now means he is the only player to play 4 or more Heads-Up's without a single win. Having said that, it was still a great night for **DAVE** as he registered the biggest ever profit in a Mystery Bounty game (£347) & the 3rd-biggest in any BCPC League game, lifting him dramatically from 131st to 38th in the career-profit table, although both **DAVE** & **EDDIE JUDGE** now sit on 49 games without getting their first win, equal-3rd All-Time.

DEBJANI DUNCAN finished 3rd to collect her first League points since Season 12 on October 17th, 2014, a gap of 11 years & 119 days! She also moved up to equal-2nd for Final Table percentage, joining **LISA WHITTINGHAM** on 54.54% (30 from 55) with husband **ANDY DUNCAN** the long-time leader in this category on 59.72%.

LAURA RHODEN extended the 3rd-longest streak of games without a win to 66 while **ETHAN HARRIS** will become the 75th different player to wear the Shirt Of Shame tonight after dropping to the foot of the table.

ADAM PHELAN was first out for the second time this season.....nobody has ever been out first three times in the same season.

DARREN RUMBOLD now has the longest active streak without a cash at 24 games...still well short of **PAUL FOY**'s record of 32.

RICKY BUCKLAND improved his League-Leading points total to 31, which is the best of his 15-season BCPC career, bettering the 29 gained in Season 22 when he finished 4th for his best-ever finish.

BCPC No.1 ranked **DAVE HALLIDAY** made his 5th successive Final Table & closed the gap on **RICKY** to 2 points. Both players need to once again make the top 10 in either of the final 2 games to have any chance of scoring more points, with **DAVE** needing 7th or better and **RICKY** needing 5th.

JAY SCOTT reached his 23rd Final Table but is still awaiting his first win, equalling the 3rd-worst run ever (**MATT WILSON**). **MARK ENGLAND** (32 games) holds that particular record and he currently sits in 142nd and last position for biggest BCPC loss (**-£545**), the first time he has ever been in this position. **BRIAN YATES** still holds the All-Time record mark at **-£578** back in Season 28, Week 4.

CHAMPIONS LEAGUE X

This game is still some way off yet, but will take place in Malvern on **SATURDAY JULY 18TH**, with the MPC defending the Title against both the BCPC & NUTS POKER. Our 3 teams, as always for this event, will be chosen using the Final League positions following Season 32. We will be entering 3 teams of 4 players and I will contact all players who qualify to play, once the season is over.

Should you qualify to play for more than one Club, You will be given the option, at that time, to choose which one you prefer. You will not be asked before this time, to choose by either myself, **LIAM** (MPC) or **CRAIG** (NUTS) to avoid any confusion or pressure.

The game is scheduled to take place less than 24 hours after BCPC Week 3, which we normally like to avoid doing. Unfortunately, we can find no alternative date before August, so have agreed to go with this one.

THE BIBLE

Beginning with tonight's game, the BCPC have now introduced our new comprehensive rule book, which has been dubbed "The Bible".



On release of The Bible, some "Wag" decided to post the above picture, which I felt needed a share..bless you **TOM!**

Now while we can laugh at the picture, The Bible is now a very important read, incorporating all playing and non-playing rules. It is published in its entirety on our website and is there for everyone to access, should you wish to do so.

I will remain as TD for each game, if available, with **STEVE HEALEY** now becoming our "Rules Guru" with the responsibility of pointing anyone towards the required ruling as and when needed.

One controversial rule which has changed in The Bible, is that of exposing cards in a hand. The hand will now no longer be killed, but the player will instead receive a penalty, which will be determined by the TD, depending upon the circumstances in which the cards were exposed.

Also, be aware that it is you, as the player, who is responsible for your actions at the tables, including announcing any actions that you make. If, for instance, you say "Raise", it is your responsibility to make yourself heard, especially to the Dealer. It is NOT the Dealers responsibility to hear you....that lies with you to make your intentions clear, whatever they may be!

These are just two rules that have been highlighted...there are many more in there, so please, have a look if you feel there is something you are unsure of or don't understand. Errors have been made this season and so hopefully, these rules will help us all to eradicate these moving forward.

One other rule to note for Season 33, beginning in May, is that your initial subs for Week 1 **MUST** be sent electronically. No cash will be taken on the night by **DAVE**, to help us with knowing the exact numbers for the opening day, as this is not always clear with cash payments taken 10 minutes before the start of a season.

While Online payments are always preferable, you will still be able to pay cash, if preferred, for the rest of next season.

STOMAHA MASTERS I

Next Friday (20th) sees the inaugural “Stomaha Masters” tournament take place, with a £20 entry fee and a 7.30pm start. This is basically a Limit Tournament, encompassing some of the Cash Games that we have played at the BCPC over several years.

The 12 games we will be playing are Badugi, Omaha, Stud, Courcheval Hi-Lo, Sviten Special, 2-7 Triple Draw, Razz, Stud Hi-Lo, A-5 Triple Draw, Omaha Hi-Lo, Pineapple...and our very own invention, “The Borg”. Starting stack will be 10k.

Each game comes with an optional Stomaha element to them, at the discretion of the dealer. These differ from game to game & include Oceans and/or Lakes, Triple Flop, 2 Turns, 1 River, 5 or 6 cards, Exposed Suits, Cards exposed face-up & a dice!....but these are all optional & may never get used.

As we have never run a Limit event before, we are winging it with regards to the structure etc... and obviously, the format of the games. But basically, I would say come along & learn some new games & give the comp a chance before making any judgements....You may even enjoy it!

ONLINE PREMIER LEAGUE (OPL) XV

The 15th running of the BCPC Online Premier League (OPL) using PokerStars 'Homegames' facility, will begin in April & I am now taking entries from anyone interested in playing.

It costs £40 to join the League & each game you play is £11, with £1 of that going towards the overall prizepool.

You play a set amount of 6-max & 9-max games, plus 3 MTT's & you play your games on days / dates to suit you, except for the MTT games which are always on a Sunday night.

The top 7 players qualify automatically for the live final, with the next 4 playing a best-of-three Heads-Up to give us 9 players for the live final.

Should we get less than 15 players enter, then the only top 4 will qualify, with 5th-8th going to the Play-Offs to make a 6-handed live final table.

Top 2 players in the League get a payout along with the top 3 in the live Final, which is played at The Wheatsheaf on a Friday date that suits all of the participants.
