MILESTONES IN WEEK THREE

DARREN RUMBOLD tops the League for the first time after picking up his first career League win at the 44th attempt. He also moved onto 27 points, which makes this his best-ever season in that respect. **DAVE MITCHELL** reached 7 points which is also his highest ever points total.

ADAM SMITH made his 17th career-cash as he finished 2nd, putting him equal-10th with **KEV BERRIE**, while **LEXI WOOD** made her first BCPC cash.

JAKE POKON took his 2nd-longest streak All-Time, for games without any win, to 58 while **EDDIE JUDGE** extended his 3rd-longest streak to 54 games.

MATT MCKINLAY finished 5th for 6 points to equal **STEVE HEALEY**'s record of scoring at least one point in 24 consecutive seasons. **MATT** has now scored points in every season in which he has played & is the only player who has played 20 or more seasons to have done so.

MATT JUDGE will tonight wear the Double-Whammy of Shirt Of Shame & Cap Of Crap, but with his total career loss now standing at **-£582**, he has gone past **PAUL FOY** by just **50p** as the biggest BCPC loser in Club history!

KEV BERRIE moved past **ANDY DUNCAN** into 11th place All-Time on 281 points while **ROB HEWLITT** went past **AMY COSHAN** into 14th place (259).

DAVE HALLIDAY has now been ranked as BCPC No.1 for 13 straight games, with the longest streak ever being 14 by **STEVE REDFERN**.

Please put this one in your diary and try to get along for a great social evening.

FEBRUARY 12TH - SEASON 34 WEEK 2 - I have been assured that this date does not clash with APAT's Team Championships so have confidently pencilled this one in. This will be a very special night for the BCPC as it is our 200th game and as such, there will be a commemorative tankard for the winner, along with a very special additional prize which will be revealed in due course.

BCPC PLO SUPER SUMMER SIZZLER SERIES 2026

EDDIE JUDGE took down his first BCPC win of any variant, with victory in Game 2 of the Sizzler Series, winning himself **£196** plus a Battle Of The Champions seat in January. **BRIAN YATES** was 2nd for **£118** with **JAY SCOTT** (**£78**) in 3rd.



That leaves the League Table looking like this, with one game to go

With 15 points for the win, any of the top 7 players could still lift the Title & the accompanying **£250** prize plus trophy, while the **£100** runner-up prize can still be won by any of the top 9 players.

GAME THREE (AUGUST 28th) is 4 CARD PLO PROGRESSIVE BOUNTY (**£15** + **£15**) with an optional **£10** (10k) add-on.

BCPC SEATS

ADAM SMITH became the 30th different player to cash using a BCPC seat when he finished 12th in the APAT World Championship Main Event last weekend for **£720**.

ADAM's win was a first of it's kind though, in that it was the first time ever that someone has cashed while playing a seat won by a different person and that situation caused quite a bit of confusion amongst those involved.

Therefore, I will outline here what happens when you win any seat at the BCPC....

All seats won, be it through a Top 10 League finish, a BAPWAC win, or any other means, will be given an expiry date of at least two years and these expiry dates will be posted on a regular basis. The criteria in which you can use these seats can be found in "The Bible" on the Website, but however they are used, each seat is played on a 50/50 basis. This means for example, that if you play a **£500** comp and cash for **£1000**, YOU keep the buy-in (**£500**), leaving **£500** to be split 50/50 between yourself (**£250**) with the remaining **£250** split evenly between all paid-up members for the season in which the seat was won.

A BAPWAC win is similar. If 5 people got a pair, the winner would play a **£225** seat on a 50/50 basis, again keeping the buy-in, with the rest split 50/50, meaning that the other 4 players would get 12.5% each of the remaining 50%.

Should a player nominate someone to play a seat for them within the two year timescale, then there is a slight difference to the payout, in that the PLAYER (NOT the seat winner) keeps the buy-in before the other splits take place. If the player then decides to chop that buy-in in any way with the seat winner, that would be a private transaction and nothing to do with the BCPC.

CHAMPIONS LEAGUE X

The 10th running of The Champions League was played out in July and it was the “C” team from the NUTS Poker League who ran out worthy winners by a 13-point margin, thanks mainly to the performance of first-time participant Callum Adams, who took 5 players out in total, including **CRAIG STANDEN** (£60) in 3rd & **DAVE WHITELEY** (£90) in 2nd, collecting £150 for the win himself.



The NUTS “C” took £680 for the win with the BCPC “B” (**BRIAN YATES, NATE POULTON, DAVE WHITELEY, EDDIE JUDGE**) collecting £280 for 2nd place.

ADAM PHELAN didn’t score in this one but remains the most successful player in Champions League history with 70 points scored, £620 won and 15 players eliminated in his 9 games played.

The next game will hopefully be set up for early 2027 with the Nuts as hosts, probably in Stafford.

BCPC GET MEDAL AT APAT WORLDS



NIC RAWLINGS bagged himself a bronze medal along with **£1400** in the “Round Of Each NLHE / PLO” at last week’s APAT World Championships.

Also in the money, and becoming the first player ever to cash using someone else’s seat, was **ADAM SMITH**, who played a BAPWAC won by the late **HITENDRA PATEL** & finished 12th in the Main Event for **£720**.

Last but not least, we have **ANDY DUNCAN**, who was in the money for his 11th place finish in the TORSE (**£280**) and for his Final Table in the 8-Game (6th, **£750**).

BCPC HIT THE WORLD SERIES MAIN EVENT



Early July and both **RICKY BUCKLAND & AMANDA SMITH** lived the dream that we all aspire to.....playing in the WSOP \$10,000 buy-in Main Event in Las Vegas!!



AMANDA had won her trip through Poker Raffles and both **MATT MCKINLAY & BRIAN YATES** had a 1% share of her action, won via BCPC Week 6 wins .

Both players made it through to Day 2 but sadly that was where the dream ended for them.

“The whole WSOP experience was incredible...the Main Event is the best tournament in the World” said **RICKY**. “I sat down very confident with no nerves. I feel I played well the whole series but the Poker Gods were against me as I seemed to run into it every day”.

AMANDA described it as “One of the most amazing experiences of my life...the people, the buildings, Vegas was incredible”

Both players had some success at the tables in other events. **RICKY** did a 4-way chop at Caesars for \$1516 where **AMANDA** cashed for \$350. **RICKY** then cashed in a WSOP Daily event for \$405 with **AMANDA** netting \$950 before she came 351st from 8007 runners for \$1950.

On the final night before coming back home, **AMANDA** had the incredible experience of winning a \$10,588 Jackpot on the slots.....and followed up with a \$2,500 win 4 hours later!!

“I can’t wait to go again & with the experience I have gained, I know I can do even better next time!” said **AMANDA**.

Well from what I can see, you both did pretty well this time! 😊

HALL OF FAME 2026

Pretty soon I will be sending out the voting requests for this year's Hall Of Fame votes. If you have played 10 or more seasons, you are eligible for induction & must then receive 15% or more of the votes cast. If you have played 5 or more seasons, you are eligible to cast 10 votes as you deem fit.

In addition to the trophies received, if you get Inducted into our BCPC Hall Of Fame, you will receive a commemorative patch as seen here, which can be ironed onto hoodies & polo shirts.



These will also be given retrospectively to past winners.
